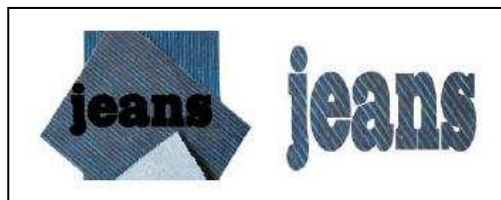


## Fill Text with patterns



Open Inkscape

File import (find your image)

Place it on the page somewhere

Type your text making sure it's a solid fill colour I used black but I don't think it matters what colour.

Place the text over the part of the image you want to show through

Drag a selection box around both

Go to

Object>clip>set (and see what happens.)

Your design can now be printed and hand cut.

If you have a Craft Robo you can get robo to cut it for you.

You will have to make your file into a jpg so that it can be auto traced in robomaster.

People will have there own ways of doing this but the way I did it was by doing a screen shot. (alt+print screen on keyboard)

I copied the print screen into paint shop pro and then did >save as< and saved it as a jpg

Opened the jpg in robomaster and did the auto trace

Put registration marks on and sent it to print and cut.
